Learning Options for 2020-2021 School Year

Option A

Providing that the Covid-19 case numbers are low and there are no governmental mandates in place, our goal is for all students to return to campus on Tuesday, August 11th for live in-person instruction. Extra safety precautions will be taken throughout the school day. All students (K-12) will be utilizing the online learning platform of Google Classroom. This platform will allow for organization of classroom assignments, delivery of materials, and work submission from the students. Teachers and students will be trained on how to access and utilize this platform.

Option B

In the event that there is a need to lower the occupancy of the school building due to DHEC or CDC guidelines or government mandates, option B would allow an opportunity for students to receive daily live instruction with alternate days of on campus instruction for grades 6-12.

Grades K-5. Students would continue to come to school for live instruction. Classroom space would be maximized by removing common areas and adding more space between each desk.

Grades 9-12. Students would continue to follow an A/B schedule rotation of classes. All classes will be live-streamed through Zoom sessions and will last for the entire 90 minutes. Half of the students (A-M) will come to school on Monday (A days) while the other half (N-Z) would log in for the live stream and watch the exact same lesson from home. On Thursdays (the other A day) the students would switch. A-M would attend virtually and N-Z would attend in person. B days would follow the same format.

Grades 6-8. Middle school students will follow the same schedule as indicated above. Periods 1,3, 5, and 7 will constitute their A day schedule and periods 2,4,6,and 8 will constitute their B day schedule.

On Wednesdays: All Grades K-12. All students will attend chapel and small group discussion groups from home on Wednesdays. There would be no students on campus on Wednesdays. This will allow for a midweek deep cleaning of the school building.

Option C

Our final option, if needed or required, is to run a fully virtual learning program. As opposed to the spring, all instruction would be in real-time by their classroom teachers and students would be required to log in for each course. Google Classroom would be used as the learning platform. Students would be required to log-in to their classes on a regular block schedule (as described above). Lower school students would also receive real-time instruction on schedules determined by their grade level. Wednesdays would follow a similar format with an at-home Worship Wednesday for all students K-12.
