## **Position Summary**

Palmetto Christian Academy is seeking a STEM Leader with a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Education, Mathematics, or Science, and 3 years of exemplary classroom teaching. The preferred candidate will also possess an ACSI and/or South Carolina teaching certificate, and have at least 1 year of experience in teaching STEM-related subjects in a Christian school setting.

Under the direction of the Academic Dean and Lower School Principal, this position is responsible for implementing the STEM pilot program. This position is also responsible for collaborating with teachers in promoting interdisciplinary STEM activities. In addition to teaching K-5 classes, additional activities include but not limited to: building relationships and working with community partners, research and implementing STEM related professional development opportunities for K-12 teachers, promoting the STEM program to parents and the community, and getting students involved in outside STEM related events (competitions, field trips, etc.).
