Position Summary

Palmetto Christian Academy is seeking a Resource Room Teacher with a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in education. The preferred candidate will also possess an ACSI and/or South Carolina teaching certificate, a Masters' Degree, and have at least 10 years of classroom experience, including training in student learning development strategies.

The Resource Room Teacher will work with the Coordinator of Resource Room Services to do the following:

- Work with a small group of students to teach remedial reading or math
- Assist the Director of Admissions in assessing student readiness and placement
- Provide one-on-one instruction for students in need of academic support
- Observe students in the classroom who are being referred to the resource program
- Help determine placement in the resource program by interpreting test scores, observing students, and listening to teacher recommendations
- Meet with parents and teachers to discuss student progress and concerns

Oualifications

- Proficient with the fundamentals of reading (including phonemic awareness, phonics, phonics rules, vocabulary development, fluency, and comprehension).
- Proficient with math fundamentals (especially number sense)
- National Institute of Learning Development (NILD)-trained or willing to be trained
